Millville is home to one of Woodford County's oldest horse farms.

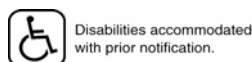
Lunch - Millville Community Center (formerly Millville School)

We will enjoy a delicious lunch creekside at the old Millville School which is now the Millville Community Center.

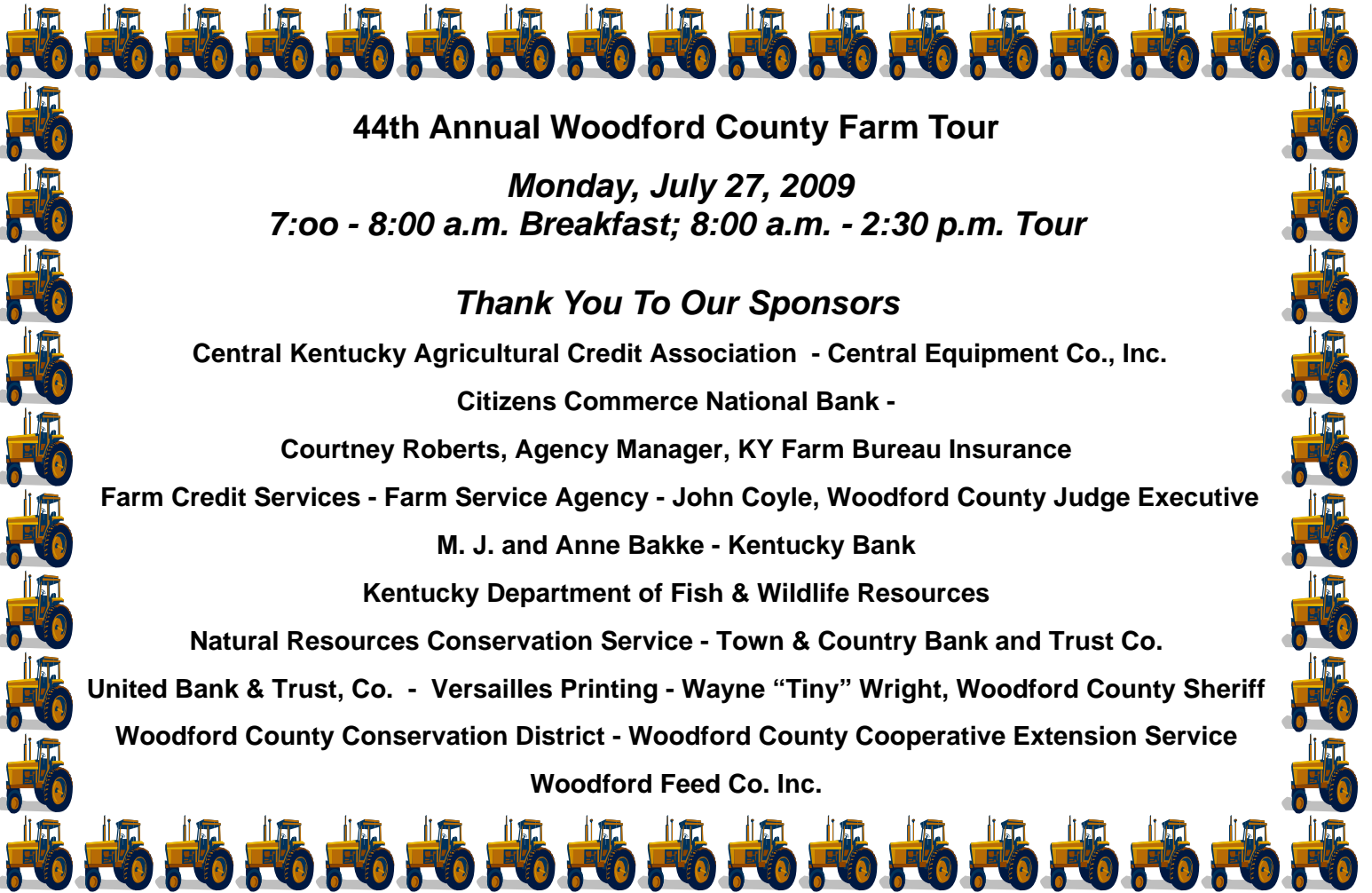
