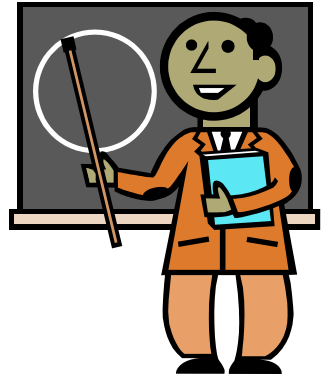


Welcome "New Teacher"
